Kevin J. McMahon became Group Vice President, Asia in January 2014 following Jacobs' acquisition of SKM, which Jacobs completed in December 2013. He joined Jacobs in 2007 when Jacobs acquired Edwards and Kelcey, a major North American Engineering Firm where he was Chairman and CEO.

Since joining Jacobs, Kevin has increased market penetration, profitability and growth.
